



Dear Parent,

Welcome back to Saturday football at Holy Trinity. This club is run solely by parents. It is a fun and informal way of getting children of all ages together. It is an opportunity to train once a week on the school field, learn more about football and give all the children a chance to play a game.

Contribution

We ask for a contribution of £5 per family per term. This goes towards the football equipment needed for the club and resources at the school. Subs are due now for the spring/summer term. Cheques can be payable to Holy Trinity PTA, otherwise cash is fine.

Parents' Responsibility

Parents are ultimately responsible for monitoring the health and safety of their children and are asked to stay for the whole session. It is vital for all parents (or a named adult responsible for your child) to remain close to the coaching area throughout the coaching session. This is to ensure that you are available should an injury occur or your child needs attention. Also, it is not unusual for a child to want to stop playing before the coaching has finished. Similarly, children have a habit of wandering off at any time, sometimes before coaching has commenced, during the session, or once the session has completed. Once a child has stopped playing, the coaches cannot be responsible for them.

Help Required

We are always in need of more help from parents to take on a coaching role, particularly as sometimes not all of us can make it. You don't need to need to be professionally trained as a coach, you just need to have an interest in football and help the children develop their skills. If you are interested in helping, let one of the coaches know.

What your children need

We recommend that each child has the appropriate footwear and clothes:

- Football boots with studs – if your child has grown out of a pair, we'll find a home for them
- Shin pads
- Football kit
- Additional clothing to keep your child warm
- A drink as they get very thirsty

Mums and dads – don't forget that you need to be warm too. Bring a chair to sit on, flask of tea, etc. Please do not park in the playground as children use this area to play in.
