Dear Parents,

The Water Board have informed us that the loss of water on Wednesday was due to a faulty pressure valve in the immediate area. Hopefully, the problem will not reoccur!

Although our communication system of one parent ringing others is effective at the beginning of the day, there were a few parents who didn't receive a message as soon as we would have wished. Apologies to those parents.

The Ascot cluster of Headteachers have previously discussed implementing a schools communication system called 'Keep Kids Safe'. In light of the situation on Wednesday, I have made the decision to go ahead with this system immediately, rather than wait for the rest of the cluster. The system is very similar to the one used at Charters School. In a situation as yesterday, the pupil's main contact would be automatically be sent a text message to their mobile phone or a message would be left on an answer phone.
